In 1998 a Village Design Statement was produced by Appleby village residents. This foundation now needs building on and transforming into our Neighbourhood Plan for the parish as whole.

#### What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

It is a way we can protect as well as support sympathetic development to ensure the parish remains sustainable.

Sustainable communities are places where people want to live and work. Meeting the diverse needs of existing and future residents. They are safe and inclusive, well planned, well built and run for the whole parish.


Once adopted by a majority of parishioners (in a mini referendum), planning decisions affecting the parish must take into account what is contained in the Neighbourhood Plan.
