- Thank you to everyone who worked hard on the refused Poultry Farm application. The applicant has the right to appeal up to 6 months after the refusal.
- The information sent to him by the resident has been forwarded to Openreach. He asked them to work to support this case and will update following a meeting with Openreach. Should have a strong case with the Defra money to support rural broadband.
- Weather warning – more than 6000 sandbags at NLC on standby.
- Vaccination program going well. Covid Rates are more favourable than the rest of the country. Care home staff and residents have been vaccinated. Highest in the UK for vaccinating this sector.
- PA/2020/1872 called to committee if the officer is mindful to approve the application.
- Pleased to see that Appleby PC has applied for the In Bloom grant.
- Have asked for the works to the path from Appleby village to Station area to be prioritised in the upcoming Council budget.

- a) Cllr Keyes asked how car parking for access to the new River Ancholme Path may affect farm traffic movements. Cllr Waltham advised that the path is a connectivity path and as such people do not normally drive to the path, locals access on foot.
- b) Footpath to Station area update – request information when work will be carried and JB Rural to complete section between nursery and rail crossing
- c) To consider and resolve Notice Board Policy – Discussion re what content could be put into Notice Board – agenda item for next meeting to resolve.
- d) To consider and note the Climate & Ecology Bill information from ERNLLCA.- Noted that NLC are already exceeding the requirements.
- e) To consider suggestions for the Highways meeting to take place on 29th January with NLC highways.- As previous meeting
 - Speed humps in strategic points not outside properties.
 - Flashing speed signs – these would come at an expense. Maybe some grant funding available.
 - Gated chicane at the entrance and exit of the village.
 - Rumble strips/red tarmac.
 - Plenty of signage, road markings.
